## **PREFACE**

#### **DEAR FELLOW CITIZENS**

Our municipality is actively committed to work for a clean and sustainable future. By introducing a new waste management system, we are also fulfilling our duty to implement the requirements of the amended law of March 12, 2012 on waste. This law requires that waste collection fees include a variable component to create a more equitable and environmentally friendly system.

From now on, additional collection of residual waste (black bin) which exceeds the 26 times included per year, will be charged extra. This adaptation aims to encourage each of us to reduce waste and preserve the environment. By producing less waste, we contribute to sustainability and to reducing our impact on the environment.

In this brochure you will find essential information about the new taxes, as well as useful tips for reducing and sorting waste. Our goal is to make this transition easier for you and to highlight the positive effects for our municipality and for the environment.

Thank you for your cooperation and your commitment to a more ecological future.

## THE BEST WASTE IS THE ONE THAT IS NOT EVEN GENERATED!

## TRY TO APPLY THE FOLLOWING BASIC RULE : **REDUCE - REUSE - RECYCLE!**

## 1 THE FIRST STEP IS TO CHANGE YOUR HABITS AND ASK YOURSELF THE RIGHT QUESTIONS!

• Avoid plastic packaging when shopping, prefer unpackaged fruits and vegetables and use reusable bags such as the eco-bag or the super-bag.





#### BEFORE BUYING A PRODUCT

- Do I really need this product?
   If yes, try to reduce your impact on the environment by choosing products that are as sustainable and ecological as possible.
- Does it come with little or no packaging and is the packaging recyclable?

## 3 BEFORE THROWING AWAY A PRODUCT THAT IS STILL USABLE OR REPAIRABLE

- Can I resell it?
- Can I give it to someone or donate it to an association?
- Can I take it to the « second hand » section of the resource centre?
- Can I fix it or have it repaired?
- Can I donate it to someone/an association that knows how to fix it?

### **4** WHEN THROWING AWAY A PRODUCT

- Take advantage of the separate collection for paper, glass, organic waste and green waste.
- Take advantage of our resource centre in L\u00e4nster Bierg.
   You can deposit many recyclable products and materials there, which allows you to reduce the amount of your residual waste.



## **LEGAL BASIS**

In accordance with the provisions of the amended law on waste management of 2012, the municipality is required to implement waste management covering all associated costs, and to collect appropriate municipal taxes for these services.

These services must be calculated based on the rule of the "paying polluter" and include all related costs. This means that investments in infrastructure, as well as current operating costs for waste management must be included in the calculation of municipal taxes.


Taxes for waste disposal must include at least one variable component based on weight or volume/collection.

The new waste management concept and the adapted taxes will apply as of April 1, 2025.

## THE MAIN CHANGES FOR RESIDUAL WASTE


#### (BLACK BIN)

- Taxes are divided into a **fixed** rate and a **variable** rate.
- The **fixed** rate is due for each bin and varies according to the size of the bin.
- The **fixed** rate includes 26 collections per year i.e., every 2 weeks.
- 2 collections per month are invoiced automatically.
- The **variable** amount is due if the bin is collected at a higher frequency than every 2 weeks and also varies according to the size of the bin.
- This collection frequency is recorded by the chip of your residual waste bin.
- From April 2025, the replacement of an existing bin costs €50 (in case of volume change), the first bin is put at your disposal free of charge.



## BIOWASTE BROWN BIN





The municipality provides 45L or 80L bins.





Weekly, starting January 1, 2025 (see collection calendar).




Other containers are not allowed and will NOT be emptied.



Bins must be put in front of the house before 7 a.m. on collection day with the lid closed.





## BIOWASTE BROWN BIN

#### **COST**

Waste collection is included in the fixed basic rate. The first bin is included in the fixed basic rate.



As of April 1, 2025 the replacement of an existing bin will be charged €50 (in case of volume change).

### **WASTE TO BE PUT IN THE BROWN BIN**

#### Kitchen waste

- leftover fruits and vegetables
- coffee grounds and tea bags
- food scraps (raw or cooked)
- bread scraps
- spoiled and expired food,
- meat and fish scraps

#### **Peelings**

- may be wrapped in newspaper paper (or in thin paper bags)
- Non-woody garden waste
- grass and turf
- weeds
- vegetables
- fallen fruits
- flowers

- hay and straw
- cut flowers
- potted plants (without pot and soil)
- leaves

### **WHAT WASTE DOES NOT GO INTO THE BROWN BIN?**

#### Waste

- cigarette butts
- fats and oils
- plastic bags (including biodegradable)
- ash and coal
- sweeps
- vacuum cleaner bags
- diapers
- small animal droppings

- cat litter
- · animal corpses
- cardboard bags
- towels and handkerchiefs

#### Woody garden waste


- shrubs
- hedges and roses
- perennials
- · sawdust and wood chips
- tree bark
- plant soil and sand

## PAPER AND CARDBOARD BLUE BIN

#### **COST**

Waste collection is included in the fixed basic rate. The first bin is included in the fixed basic rate.



As of April 1, 2025 the replacement of an existing bin will be charged €50 (in case of volume change).

### ✓ WASTE TO BE PUT IN THE BLUE BIN

#### All types of printed paper

- newspapers
- magazines
- advertisements and flyers
- catalogues
- books and notebooks
- calendars
- cartons
- egg boxes
- etc.

### **WHAT WASTE SHOULD NOT GO INTO THE BLUE BIN?**

- Tetra Pak drink cartons
- wallpapers
- milk and fruit juice cartons
- contaminated paper (for example with oil, paint or food scraps)
- paper covered with a thin layer of wax or plastic
- carbon paper and peeling paper
- binders
- cardboard plates
- etc.



## HOLLOW GLASS GREEN BIN

#### **COST**

Waste collection is included in the fixed basic rate. The first bin is included in the fixed basic rate.



As of April 1, 2025 the replacement of an existing bin will be charged €50 (in case of volume change).

### ✓ WASTE TO BE PUT IN THE GREEN BIN

- wine bottles
- beer bottles
- juice and other glass bottles
- glass containers for vegetables and fruits
- jam jars
- perfume bottles
- other glass containers

### **WHAT WASTE SHOULD NOT GO INTO THE GREEN BIN?**

- ceramics
- earthenware
- porcelain
- mirrors
- flat glass
- window glazing
- reinforced glass
- safety glass
- glass bricks
- car windows
- refractory glass
- fluorescent tubes
- light bulbs
- glass used cathode ray tubes

You can deposit this waste at the resource centre.







## VALORLUX BLUE BAGS

#### **COLLECTION AND COST**

Free collection every 2 weeks (see collection calendar). Valorlux blue bags are available free of charge from the municipality.







## **RESIDUAL WASTE**

## **BLACK BIN**





The municipality provides waste bins of 45L, 60L, 80L, 120L, 240L, 660L or 1100L.





Weekly (see collection calendar)






Every household is required to have at least one residual waste bin.





Bins must be put in front of the house before 7 a.m. on collection day with the lid closed.



## RESIDUAL WASTE BLACK BIN

#### **COST**

Taxes are divided into a fixed rate and a variable rate.

The fixed rate includes 26 collections per year - i.e., in general every 2 weeks.

2 collections per month are invoiced automatically.

The variable amount is due if the bin is emptied at a higher frequency than every 2 weeks. Both rates vary depending on the size of the bin.

The first bin is included in the fixed basic rate.



As of April 1, 2025 the replacement of an existing bin will be charged €50 (in case of volume change).

#### CHOOSE THE BIN THAT SUITS YOUR NEEDS

You have the choice between different sizes of bins. Choose the one that suits your actual needs. In residential buildings, the building management will determine the best solution together with the inhabitants. The building management can contact the municipality or SIGRE if necessary.

#### THE EXISTING 45L BIN IS QUITE FULL EVERY WEEK

**The 45L bin** continues to be **collected every** week (i.e., 52 collections / year)

Fixed rate per year	€172
Variable rate per year	€260*
Total	€432

<sup>\*</sup> In this case, 26 x 1 additional collections at 10 € will be added, making a total of € 260.

The 45L bin is exchanged for an **80L** bin and **collected every 2 weeks** (i.e., 26 collections / year)

Fixed rate per year	€338
Variable rate per year	€0*

<sup>\*</sup> In this case, **no additional collection** would be necessary and there would be no additional costs.

#### THE EXISTING 45L BIN IS NOT FULL EVERY WEEK

The 45L bin is exchanged for a 60L bin and collected every 2 weeks (i.e., 26 collections / year)

<sup>\*</sup> In this case, **no additional collection** would be necessary and there would be no additional costs.

The 45L bin is exchanged for a 60L bin, collected every 2 weeks and 1 additional time per quarter (i.e., 26 collections / year + 4 additional collections)

<sup>\*</sup> In this case, it is necessary to add 4 additional collections at €15, i.e. a total of €60.








## RESIDUAL WASTE ANALYSIS 2021 | 2022

Even though the amount of residual waste per person has decreased significantly since 2013, on average, more than 60% of residual waste still consists of waste that can be recycled (recyclable products and materials).

Use the different bins available to you and systematically separate your waste: you will then not only reduce the quantity, but also the costs.




## **WASTE TAX BILLING**

- Waste tax is billed per quarter (i.e., 4 times a year) together with taxes on water and sanitation (Invoice Municipal Taxes).
- The **fixed** tax is invoiced quarterly, i.e. 4 times a year.
- The variable tax is invoiced in the 2nd and 4th quarter, or 2 times a year.
- In the event of a change in volume, relocation or death, the rates will be calculated in proportion to the months of use.

## **HOW CAN I SAVE MONEY?**

- 1) Sort your waste: most of the waste can be disposed of in the blue, green or brown bin. You can deposit many recyclable materials at the resource centre.
- 2 Avoid unnecessary collections: 26 collections per year, thus, at least two collections per month, are included in the fixed basic rate. Each additional collection leads to additional costs!
- 3 Take out your bin only when it is full.




## RESIDUAL WASTE BIN IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

Since last year, the black bins for residual waste have an electronic chip. At the time of collection, the data from the chip is transmitted to the waste collection vehicle. This is an identification number that does not contain any personal data.



As of April 2025, billing will be based on the volume of the bin and the frequency of collections (no personal data will be transmitted to the waste collection company). Thus, you can positively influence the amount to be paid by sorting your waste and making better use of recycling options.



## **LOCKS FOR BINS**

As of April 1, 2025 you can order a lock for your bin. The installation will be done by appointment.

In case of loss, damage or replacement (change of volume) of the bin, a new lock needs to be ordered and a new invoice will be issued.

If you move out of the municipality, no refund will be granted.

## **BULKY WASTE**

The municipality organizes the collection of bulky waste at your home only by appointment and against prior payment. The price is €40 per cubic meter (m3), with a maximum of 3 cubic meters (m3) per collection.

## WASTE FROM GRASS, HEDGES AND SHRUBS

You can deposit green waste at the Junglinster recycling centre. You can also deposit your cut grass in a container at the municipal deposit (8, rue Ronnheck in Junglinster). It is not allowed to open the container to deposit waste.

The municipality organizes a collection twice a year for the pruning of hedges and shrubs. You will find the details as well as the collection dates in the various communication channels of the municipality (Mag, social networks, website and mobile application).

## **RESOURCE CENTRE**

### (RECYCLING CENTRE)

As a citizen of the municipality of Junglinster, you can enter the recycling centre with an access card. If you have not received this card, please contact the municipality.
